

Agenda 21 is the official report of the United Nations World Conference on Environment and Development held in Rio de Janeiro in 1992 and attended by 172 Governments. George H.W. Bush attended the conference as representative of the United States and signed off on the report. The report is a plan that calls for the international control and regulation of virtually every aspect of human activity that might impact the environment, which is essentially everything humans do, and makes humans subservient to the planet. By signing the report, which has the effect of a treaty, each nation is pledged to adopt the goals of Agenda 21, the effect of which is to give up our freedom to the United Nations. Despite the Senate not ratifying the report In 1995 President Clinton signed Executive Order #12858 to create the Council on Sustainable Development to coordinate US environmental policies with the UN directives outlined in Agenda 21. The EO also directed all agencies of the Federal Government to work with the state and local community governments to institute these policies throughout the US. George W. Bush endorsed Agenda 21 and recently President Obama signed EP 13575 creating the White House Rural Council. The WHRC is made up of 25 Agency heads and the Vice President and includes Homeland Security and Health and Human Services. The Secretary of Agriculture is the Chairman.

The purpose of the Council is to more quickly and readily implement the polities of Agenda 21
